

Required Software: SSH/Telnet Client

Steps provided using PuTTY. Download available here: http://www.putty.org/







- Open PuTTY and enable Logging of your session output
 - Click "Session" then "Logging" as shown to the left
 - In Options click "All session output" radio button
 - **1c** Choose the path and log file name to put the logging data
- Click on Session, enter the reader's IP address, Select SSH, and hit Open

- PuTTY Security Alert will open, select "Yes"
- Log into the reader
 - Username: root
 - Password: impinj
- At the > prompt type the following commands:
 - 5a Check reader configuration: show network summary
 - Check LLRP connection: show rfid llrp inbound
 - Check log files: show logging events err 1000 show logging events app 1000
 - 5d Exit the reader: exit
